Floating Education & Health Centre: Bangladesh



During the monsoon season (June to October), children cannot attend school and communities cannot access health care facilities because their villages are completely cut off from mainland services by flooding.

Our two floating education and health centres provide quality education and health services during the day. In the evenings, they act as a community resource centre, serving 150,000 members of the target population with health and social awareness programmes to improve their health-seeking behaviour and to encourage them to practise their human rights and access government services.

Impact 1: 500 children aged 6-14 and 100 young people aged 13-18 receive quality education.

Impact 2: We provide reproductive health services (ante natal, safe delivery and post natal care) to 1,000 pregnant mothers.

Child Labour Elimination Project: Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh



In the Cox's Bazar region of Bangladesh, we have identified 6,500 children working in fish-drying factories. Working in this industry, they suffer severe injuries and illnesses as a result of sharp tools, raw fish, chemicals and pesticides.

Learning for Life with local partners, POPI and HELP, in conjunction with Comic Relief, has started a project which will create an enabling environment. We support children, parents/guardians, employers, duty bearers and other key stakeholders (including government), with the release and reintegration of child labourers and gain commitment from all groups not to engage in hazardous child labour in the future.

Impact 1: So far, 500 children have been released from hazardous work and are now in full-time education.

Impact 2: Our Information, Education & Communication van has ensured that the whole community knows that child labour is illegal.

This child's parents can't afford to send him to school. We think he can't afford to miss out on an education. Please help us to change his and many other children's lives.
